CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

A. Background of The Topic

"Patriarchal is a term that generally used to refer to male power in the control of women that refer to systems that make women remaining to be controlled through a variety of ways that emerge and developed along with the rotation of the world." as said by Susilowati (2013). Sarah Gamble mentions the general description of feminism as "The belief that women, purely and simply because they are women, are treated inequitably within a society which is organized to prioritise male viewpoints and concerns" (2006). As the more detail of feminism description, other expert says:

Feminism is an understanding, study and social movement that aims to change the subordinate status of women in society that prioritizes men's perspectives. A society that prioritizes the interests of men over the interests of women is the definition of a patriarchal society (Weedon (1987) in Wright, (2006)).

The existence of feminism is an effect of the existence of patriarchy, a system that puts men as the superior part while women as the inferior. "Feminism is a movement that began among 1550 - 1700 in England as the form of struggles to face patriarchal" as said by Wright, (2006). The statement shows how old feminism movement is, so that is possible for the writer talks about feminism in old Europe like Paulo Coelho does. Although feminism had been begun before this century, on the reality, there are many patriarchal systems happen currently. Many societies think this is a normal system that has to be obeyed by women and feel women who are feminists are rebelious women that are wrong.

B. Reason For Choosing The Topic

Patriarchal system has been existed in this world, in every side on the world without exception, from east cross to west. In Indonesia itself, patriarchal system is reputed as something normal, likewise what happens at the author's environment.
