## **OVERVIEW OF THE BRIDE-TO-BE'S KNOWLEDGE ABOUT REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH AT THE AMPENAN DISTRICT RELIGIOUS AFFAIRS OFFICE IN MATARAM CITY, WEST NUSA TENGGARA PROVINCE IN 2020**

### **ABSTRAK**

**Background :** The importance of reproductive health checks for future brides to find out sexually transmitted infections including HIV/AIDS is a major health problem both in the world and in Indonesia. NTB Province HIV/AIDS cases found in all districts/cities in NTB province in 2017 were 98 HIV cases and 111 AIDS cases, while in 2018 there were 155 HIV cases and 101 new AIDS cases. With the high number of HIV AIDS cases in NTB, it is an important concern for the bride and groom to know the importance of reproductive health before marriage.

**Types of research :** the type of research used is descriptive with a qualitative approach. Respondents were prospective brides at the Office of Religious Affairs, Ampenan District, Mataram City and registered as prospective brides at the Ampenan District Religious Affairs Office, the determination of respondents was purposive and 5 respondents aged 16-20 years, 2 worked as online traders and 3 respondents did not work.

**Result :** The results obtained in this study are that the knowledge of the prospective bride and groom about reproductive health in the Office of Religious Affairs, Ampenan District, Mataram City, West Nusa Tenggara Province, there is still a lack of knowledge of young brides, aged 16-20 years, regarding reproductive health because there is still no socialization. or counseling on reproductive health conducted from the Office of Religious Affairs in Ampenan District and from the Puskesmas.

**conclusion :** From this research, the reproductive health of the bride and groom is very much influenced by the low knowledge of the prospective bride and groom about reproductive health, so that the bride and groom do not know what diseases can arise in reproductive health disorders. Suggestions for the KUA Ampenan and puskesmas to further increase the education about reproductive health that can increase the knowledge of the prospective bride and groom about the importance of reproductive health.
