**GAMBARAN DUKUNGAN KELUARGA PADA CALON PENGANTIN  
(CATIN) DALAM PEMBERIAN IMUNISASI TT DI WILAYAH  
KERJA KUA GAMPING KABUPATEN SLEMAN  
D.I YOGYAKARTA**

**ABSTRAK**

**Latar Belakang:** Pasangan calon pengantin (catin) sudah tidak asing dengan pemeriksaan kesehatan pranikah. Imunisasi TT calon pengantin merupakan program pemerintah yang bertujuan mengendalikan infeksi tetanus faktor resiko kematian ibu dan bayi. Dukungan keluarga adalah dukungan yang paling berarti bagi calon pengantin. Hasil wawancara dilakukan pada 9 calon pengantin wanita hanya ada 2 yang melakukan imunisasi TT catin, 7 catin wanita tidak melakukan imunisasi TT. Tujuan penelitian untuk mengetahui bagaimana gambaran dukungan keluarga pada calon pengantin (catin) dalam pemberian imunisasi TT di Wilayah Kerja KUA Kabupaten Sleman Yogyakarta.

**Metode:** Jenis penelitian deskriptif kuantitatif, pendekatan *cross sectional*. Jumlah populasi 33 calon pegantin WUS dilakukan tanggal 17-31 Januari 2021. Teknik pengambilan sampel dengan *probability sampling* metode total Sampling. Pengumpulan data menggunakan kuesioner tertutup dan analisa data *univariat*.

**Hasil:** Karakteristik berdasarkan umur dari 33 responden berusia 20-35 tahun 28 responden (84,8%). Pendidikan terakhir SMA 15 responden (45,5%). Pekerjaan swasta dan wiraswasta 9 responden (27,3%). Gambaran dukungan keluarga dalam pemberian imunisasi TT meliputi dukungan informasional dalam kategori dukungan baik yaitu 20 responden (60,6%), dukungan penilaian mayoritas kurang 21 responden (63,6%), dukungan instrumental mayoritas kurang 20 responden (60,6%), dukungan emosional mayoritas baik 21 responden (63,6%). Hasil tabulasi silang karakteristik dan dukungan keluarga menunjukkan dukungan kurang adalah kisaran umur 20-35 tahun, pendidikan terakhir SMA, bekerja swasta dan wiraswasta.

**Simpulan:** Gambaran dukungan keluarga pada calon pengantin (catin) dalam pemberian imunisasi TT mayoritas kurang sebanyak 19 responden (57,6%). Hasil data 4 indikator dukungan didapatkan hasil dukungan penilaian kurang 21 responden (63,6%) dan dukungan emosional baik 21 responden (63,6%).

**THE DESCRIPTION OF FAMILY SUPPORT FOR PROSPECTIVE BRIDAL  
(CATIN) IN GIVING TT IMMUNIZATION IN THE WORKING AREA  
KUA GAMPING, SLEMAN DISTRICT SPECIAL  
REGION OF YOGYAKARTA**

**ABSTRACT**

**Background:** The prospective bridal (catin) are familiar with pre-marital medical checks. Immunization of TT for prospective bridal is a government program that aims to control tetanus infection, a risk factor for maternal and infant mortality. The family support is the most meaningful support for the prospective bridal. The results of interviews were conducted with 9 prospective brides, only 2 of them who immunized TT catin, while 7 prospective brides did not immunize TT. The research objective was to find out how the description of family support for the prospective bridal (catin) in giving TT immunization in the KUA Work Area, Sleman District, Yogyakarta.

**Method:** This type of research is descriptive quantitative with cross sectional approach. The total population of 33 WUS candidates was conducted on 17-31 January 2021. The sampling technique was using probability sampling with the total sampling method. Data collection using closed questionnaires and univariate data analysis.

**Results:** Characteristics based on age from 33 respondents aged 20-35 years old 28 respondents (84.8%). The latest education is high school 15 respondents (45.5%). Private work and self-employed 9 respondents (27.3%). The description of family support in giving TT immunization includes informational support in the good support category, namely 20 respondents (60.6%), 21 respondents (63.6%) less than 21 respondents (63.6%), the majority of instrumental support is less than 20 respondents (60.6%), the majority of good emotional support 21 respondents (63.6%). The results of the cross tabulation of characteristics and family support showed that the lack of support was the age range of 20-35 years old, the last education was high school, private work and self-employed.

**Conclusion:** The description of family support for the prospective bridal (catin) in giving TT immunization, the majority was less than 19 respondents (57.6%). The results of the data for 4 indicators of support showed that 21 respondents (63.6%) lacked assessment support and 21 respondents (63.6%) had good emotional support.
