**RELATIONSHIP OF PARENTING PATTERNS AND TEEN SMOKING
BEHAVIOR: A LITERATURE STUDY**

ABSTRAC

Background: In the current era, smoking in adolescents is a common practice. However, this cannot be ignored, in this case the parenting style can be one of the factors causing smoking behavior in adolescents.

Objective: to identify the relationship between parenting style and smoking behavior in adolescents.

Methods: This literature review used databases from Pubmed PMC and Google Scholar

Results: 3 national articles and 1 international article stated that there was a relationship between parenting styles and smoking behavior in adolescents, but there was 1 international journal which stated that there was no relationship between parenting and smoking behavior, this is because parenting is not the only factor that influence from smoking behavior, such as peer influence, cigarette advertisements and adolescent personality. The parenting styles that are widely used from the 5 articles are authoritarian and permissive parenting.

Conclusion: there is a relationship between parenting style and smoking behavior in adolescents
