“Gambaran Persepsi Masyarakat dan Perilaku vaksinasi COVID-19 di Desa Lerep Kecamatan Ungaran Barat Kabupaten Semarang”.

ABSTRAK

Latar Belakang : Salah satu upaya untuk mengatasi pandemic selain penerapan protokol kesehatan adalah dengan melakukan vaksinasi. Pemerintah telah mengupayakan pemberian vaksin secara gratis bagi masyarakat. Masih banyak masyarakat yang menolak untuk melakukan vaksinasi meskipun pemerintah sudah melakukan ancaman administrative bagi yang menolak. Beberapa faktor yang dimungkinkan penyebab target cakupan vaksin belum tercapai diantaranya persepsi dan perilaku masyarakat terkait dengan vaksin covid-19. Tujuan penelitian ini adalah mengetahui gambaran persepsi masyarakat dan perilaku vaksinasi COVID-19 di Desa Lerep Kecamatan Ungaran Barat Kabupaten Semarang.

Metode : Desain penelitian ini deskriptif dengan pendekatan *survey*. Populasi dalam penelitian ini adalah masyarakat di Desa Lerep Kecamatan Ungaran Barat Kabupaten Semarang dengan sampel sebanyak 100 orang yang diambil dengan teknik *quota sampling*.

Hasil : Persepsi masyarakat tentang vaksin covid-19 hampir semua kategori positif yaitu sebanyak 93 orang (93,0%). Perilaku masyarakat untuk vaksin covid-19 hampir semua kategori baik yaitu sebanyak 94 orang (94,0%).

Saran : Diharapkan masyarakat agar selalu meng-update informasi terbaru mengenai vaksin covid-19 dari sumber yang terpercaya seperti website kementerian kesehatan ataupun WHO serta menerapkan protokol kesehatan agar terhindar dari infeksi covid-19 dan dapat melindungi orang yang berada disekitar.

"Description of Public Perception and Behavior for COVID-19 Vaccination in Lerep Village, Ungaran Barat District, Semarang Regency"

ABSTRACT

Background: One of the efforts to overcome the pandemic other than the implementation of health protocols is by vaccinating. The government has made efforts to provide free vaccines for the community. There are still many people who refuse to vaccinate even though the government has made administrative threats for those who refuse. Several factors may have caused the vaccine coverage target to have not been achieved, including public perceptions and behaviors related to the COVID-19 vaccine. The purpose of this study was to describe the public perception and behavior for COVID-19 vaccination in Lerep Village, Ungaran Barat District, Semarang Regency.

Methods: The design of this research is descriptive with a survey approach. The population in this study is the community in Lerep Village, Ungaran Barat District, Semarang Regency with a sample of 100 people taken by quota sampling technique.

Results: Public perception of the covid-19 vaccine is almost all positive categories, namely as many as 93 people (93,0%). The behavior of the community for the covid-19 vaccine is almost all good categories, as many as 94 people (94,0%).

Suggestion: It is hoped that the public will always update the latest information about the COVID-19 vaccine from trusted sources such as the Ministry of Health website or WHO and implement health protocols to avoid infection with COVID-19 and protect people around them.
