CHAPTER III

METHODOLOGY

A. Research Methodologies

This study employs a qualitative research method that includes the stages of description, reduction, and selection. The research stage begins by observing the depiction of the characters and the issues raised in the novel, then continues to reduce the information obtained from the description stage and focuses on the issues raised in the theme, and finally connects the data obtained with the theory used.

1. Research Design

This research was a descriptive qualitative study, and the results were presented using a qualitative research methodology. Some experts have a different point of view and have an opinion concerning this sort of study. Shark (2002) state that according to the definition of meaning inquiry, researchers aim to understand how others make sense of their experiences, and that this sort of inquiry is founded in the world of experience. He describes qualitative research as "a sort of systematic exploratory research into meaning" (p. 4), implying that research is planned, arranged, and made public in accordance with rules agreed upon by members of the qualitative research community. Data has been collected through library research, which included looking for relevant books, journals, articles, and other sources. Using this technique, the researcher identified statements that contradicted the maxims present in the novels.
