

#### ABSTRACT

This study analyzes the novel by H.G Wells with the title "The Island Of Doctor" Moreau" using the psychological theory of Sigmund Freud. The researcher aims to find out the most dominant personality in Moreau and also whether the two personalities possessed by the human creature Moreau and the personality that will dominate in the human creature Moreau. This research uses qualitative descriptive as the method, in which the author gives some take a note and signs in sentences or conversations in novels that contain Id, Ego, Superego and Alter Ego in it.
