## THE RELATIONSHIP OF FAMILY SOCIALIZATION FUNCTIONS WITH SMOKING BEHAVIOR IN ADOLESCENTS OF SMP N 8 PATI

### ABSTRACT

**Background :** In the case of adolescents whose family functions do not work well, which is caused by smoking behavior among mothers and fathers as the main peak for adolescent smoking, the smoking behavior model described by parents influences adolescents to try it. Families that lack the socialization function are faced with instilling values and norms in their children. The implementation of proper family functions can support the realization of quality human and family resources, family characteristics can affect the optimization of family functions.

**Destination :** To determine the relationship between family socialization function and smoking behavior in adolescents.

**Methods:** The design of this study used an analytical survey with a cross-sectional approach. The population used was 305 children with a sample of 75 elderly people with *proportional random sampling technique*. The instrument used is a questionnaire which is tested for validity and reliability . Analysis of the data used is *the Chi-Square test*.

**Results:** The function of family socialization for students of SMP N 8 Pati is in the good category with a total of 71 (94.7%) respondents. Adolescents who do not smoke are in the good category with a total of 68 (90.7%) respondents . There is a relationship between the function of family socialization and smoking behavior in adolescents at SMP 8 Pati with a Sig value in this study of 0.734 .

**Conclusion :** There is a relationship between the function of family socialization with smoking behavior in adolescents at SMP 8 Pati .

**Suggestion:** For parents and families in order to improve family socialization by maintaining good communication with children so that the function of family socialization goes well.
