**EVALUASI KESESUAIAN PERESEPAN OBAT ANTIHIPERTENSI
PASIEN RAWAT JALAN BERDASARKAN FORMULARIUM DI RUMAH
SAKIT PURI ASIH PERIODE JANUARI-DESEMBER 2021**

ABSTRAK

Latar Belakang : Penulisan resep sesuai formularium rumah sakit merupakan salah satu indikator dalam standar pelayanan minimal di rumah sakit dengan standar 100%. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui persentase kesesuaian dalam persepan obat hipertensi pada pasien rawat jalan berdasarkan formularium rumah sakit. **Metode :** Penelitian ini berjenis deskriptif analisis data dengan metode retrospektif dari persepan obat hipertensi periode januari-desember 2021. Pengambilan sampel menggunakan rumus slovin. Sampel yang digunakan sebanyak 420 resep kemudian data tersebut dilakukan pengolahan data dan menghitung persentase kesesuaian persepan obat antihipertensi berdasarkan formularium rumah sakit. **Hasil Penelitian :** Berdasarkan persentase karakteristik pasien menurut jenis kelamin mayoritas pasien perempuan dengan terapi obat antihipertensi tertinggi diperoleh sebesar 59,05% sedangkan pasien laki-laki sebesar 40,95%. **Kesimpulan :** Kesesuaian persepan obat antihipertensi pasien rawat jalan berdasarkan formularium dengan hasil persentase karakteristik pasien menurut jenis kelamin pasien perempuan dengan terapi obat antihipertensi tertinggi diperoleh sebesar 59,05%.

**EVALUATION OF THE ADJUSTMENT OF PRESCRIPTION OF
ANTIHYPERTENSIVE DRUG FOR OUTPATIENT PATIENTS BASED
ON FORMULARIUM AT PURI ASIH HOSPITAL FOR THE PERIOD OF
JANUARY-DECEMBER 2021**

ABSTRACT

Background : Writing prescriptions according to the hospital formulary is one of the indicators in the minimum service standards in hospitals with 100% standards. This study aims to determine the percentage of compliance in prescribing hypertension drugs to outpatients based on the hospital formulary. Methods: This study is a descriptive type of data analysis with a retrospective method of prescribing hypertension drugs for the period January-December 2021. Sampling uses the Slovin formula. The sample used was 420 prescriptions, then the data was processed and calculated the percentage of compliance with antihypertensive drug prescriptions based on the hospital formulary. Research Results: Based on the percentage of patient characteristics according to gender, the majority of female patients with the highest antihypertensive drug therapy were obtained at 59.05% while male patients were 40.95%. Conclusion: The suitability of outpatient antihypertensive drug prescribing based on the formulary with the results of the percentage of patient characteristics by gender of female patients with the highest antihypertensive drug therapy was obtained at 59.05%.
