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“Hubungan Pengetahuan Ibu Hamil tentang Persalinan dengan Kesiapan Ibu Hamil Trimester III dalam Menghadapi Persalinan di Puskesmas Leyangan Tahun 2022”.

ABSTRAK

Latar Belakang: Ketidaksiapan ibu dalam menghadapi persalinan menjadi salah satu faktor penyebab tingginya angka kematian ibu (AKI) dan angka kematian bayi (AKB). Terjadinya kematian ibu terkait faktor pengetahuan tentang persalinan. Tujuan penelitian ini untuk mengetahui hubungan pengetahuan ibu hamil tentang persalinan dengan kesiapan ibu hamil trimester III dalam menghadapi persalinan di Puskesmas Leyangan.

Metode: Desain penelitian ini *analitik korelasional* dengan pendekatan *cross sectional*. Populasi penelitian ini seluruh ibu hamil trimester III yang memeriksakan kehamilan di Puskesmas Leyangan, sampel yang diteliti sebanyak 31 orang diambil menggunakan metode *Accidental Sampling*. Alat pengambilan data menggunakan kuesioner. Data dianalisis menggunakan uji *Chi Square* yang diolah dengan program pengolahan data SPSS.

Hasil: Hasil penelitian menunjukkan ibu hamil trimester III mempunyai pengetahuan tentang persalinan sebagian besar kategori baik (51,6%) dan mempunyai kesiapan menghadapi persalinan sebagian besar kategori baik (51,6%). Ada hubungan yang bermakna pengetahuan tentang persalinan dengan kesiapan menghadapi persalinan pada ibu hamil trimester III di Puskesmas Leyangan Kecamatan Ungaran Timur Kabupaten Semarang, dengan *p value* sebesar 0,000 ($\alpha = 0,05$).

Simpulan: Kesimpulan penelitian ini adalah semakin baik pengetahuan tentang persalinan maka semakin baik pula kesiapan yang dimiliki ibu hamil dalam menghadapi persalinan.

"Relationship between Knowledge of Pregnant Women about Childbirth and the Readiness of Third Trimester Pregnant Women in Facing Childbirth at the Leyangan Health Center in 2022".

ABSTRACT

Background: Mother's unpreparedness in facing childbirth is one of the factors causing the high maternal mortality rate (MMR) and infant mortality rate (IMR). The occurrence of maternal deaths related to knowledge about childbirth. To determine the relationship between the knowledge of pregnant women about childbirth and the readiness of third trimester pregnant women in facing childbirth at the Leyangan Health Center.

Method: The research design is correlational analytic with a cross sectional approach. The population of this study were all third trimester pregnant women who assessed pregnancy at the Leyangan Health Center, the sample studied was 31 people taken using the accidental sampling method. Data collection tool using a questionnaire. Data were analyzed using the Chi Square test which was processed with the SPSS data processing program.

Result: Research results show pregnant women in the third trimester had mostly good knowledge about childbirth (51.6%) and had good readiness to face childbirth (51.6%). There is a significant relationship between knowledge about childbirth and readiness for childbirth in third trimester pregnant women at the Leyangan Health Center, East Ungaran District, Semarang Regency, with a p value of 0.000 ($\alpha = 0.05$).

Conclusion: The conclusion of this study is that the better the knowledge about childbirth, the better the readiness that pregnant women have in facing childbirth.
