**HUBUNGAN MOTIVASI DAN SIKAP IBU DENGAN DETEKSI DINI KANKER
SERVIKS DI UPTD PUSKESMAS HALIWEN
KABUPATEN BELU**

ABSTRAK

Latar Belakang : Sebagian besar pasien kanker leher rahim yang datang berobat sudah berada pada stadium lanjut dan 50% kasus baru kanker leher rahim terjadi pada wanita yang sebelumnya tidak pernah melakukan pemeriksaan deteksi dini kanker serviks. Ini di karenakan motivasi dan sikap ibu yang mempengaruhi menurunnya deteksi dini kanker serviks dengan metode IVA

Tujuan Penelitian : Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui hubungan motivasi dan sikap ibu dengan deteksi dini kanker serviks di UPTD Puskesmas haliwen kabupaten Belu

Metode Penelitian : jenis penelitian Analitik dengan pendekatan *cross sectional* yang di laksanakan pada bulan juni yaitu 14 juni - 04 juli 2023. Populasi PUS 2460 wanita sudah menikah sebanyak 68 orang dengan tehnik pengambilan sample dengan *accidental sampling* serta intrumen penelitian adalah kuesioner, analisa data menggunakan uji chi square

Hasil Penelitian: hasil *uji chi square* motivasi : menunjukkan ada hubungan signifikan antara motivasi ibu terhadap deteksi dini kanker serviks ($p= 0,001$) dan hasil *uji cie square* ($P= 0,46$) Sikap tidak ada hubungan yang signifikan anatara sikap ibu dengan deteksi dini kanker serviks di UPTD Puskesmas haliwen, karena ibu ibu yang menjadi responden mempunyai sikap yang positif terhadap deteksi dini kanker serviks di UPTD Puskesmas Haliwen,disarankan bagi petugas kesehatan untuk meningkatkan pengetahuan bagi para ibu tentang deteksi dini kanker serviks

Kesimpulan : terdapat hubungan motivasi ibu dengan deteksi dini kanker serviks dan sikap tidak ada hubungan yang signifikan dengan deteksi dini kanker serviksdan sudah banyak ibu yang bersikap positif terhadap deteksi dini kanker serviks di UPTD Puskesmas Haliwen

**THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN MOTHERS' MOTIVATION AND
ATTITUDE WITH EARLY DETECTION OF CERVICAL CANCER AT
UPTD PUSKESMAS HALIWEN, BELU REGENCY**

ABSTRACT

Background: Most cervical cancer patients who come for treatment are already at an advanced stage and 50% of new cases of cervical cancer occur in women who have never previously done an early detection examination of cervical cancer. This is due to the motivation and attitude of mothers who influence the decline in early detection of cervical cancer with the IVA method

Research Objective: This study aims to determine the relationship between maternal motivation and attitude with early detection of cervical cancer at UPTD Haliwen Health Center, Belu Regency

Research Method: type of analytical research with a cross sectional approach which will be carried out in June, namely June 14 - July 4, 2023. The population of EFA 2460 married women is 68 people with sample collection techniques with accidental sampling and research instruments are questionnaires, data analysis using chi square tests

Research Results: Chi Square motivation test results: showed a significant relationship between maternal motivation for early detection of cervical cancer ($p = 0.001$) and chi square test results ($P = 0.46$) Attitude there was no significant relationship between maternal attitude and early detection of cervical cancer at UPTD Haliwen Health Center, because mothers who were respondents had a positive attitude towards early detection of cervical cancer at UPTD Haliwen Health Center, It is recommended for health workers to increase knowledge for mothers about early detection of cervical cancer

Conclusion: there is a relationship between maternal motivation and early detection of cervical cancer and there is no significant relationship with early detection of cervical cancer and many mothers have a positive attitude towards early detection of cervical cancer at UPTD Haliwen Health Center
