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GAMBARAN PENERAPAN SASARAN KESELAMATAN PASIEN PADA PERAWAT DI RSUD KESESI KABUPATEN PEKALONGAN

ABSTRAK

Latar Belakang: *patient safety* merupakan prioritas utama yang berkaitan dengan mutu pelayanan dan citra rumah sakit. Perawat memiliki peranan penting dan krusial dalam memastikan pemberian asuhan berfokus pada keselamatan pasien dan pencegahan cedera pada pasien selama perawatan. penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui gambaran penerapan sasaran keselamatan pasien pada Perawat di RSUD Kesesi.

Metode Penelitian: penelitian deskriptif dengan desain *cross sectional*. Teknik sampling menggunakan *purposive sampling* dengan jumlah sampel sebanyak 44 orang Perawat pelaksana. Instrumen menggunakan kuisioner *International Patient Safety Goals*. Hasil penelitian dianalisis dengan analisa univariat

Hasil: karakteristik responden sebagian besar berusia 36-45 tahun (61,4%), berjenis kelamin perempuan (61,4%), tingkat pendidikan DIII Keperawatan (88,6%) dengan masa kerja ≥ 5 tahun (72,7%). Penerapan ketepatan identifikasi pasien baik (100%), komunikasi efektif masih kurang (77,3%), peningkatan keamanan obat yang perlu diwaspadai masih kurang (61,4%), Kepastian tepat-lokasi, tepat-prosedur, tepat-pasien operasi baik (100%), pengurangan risiko infeksi terkait pelayanan kesehatan masih kurang (56,8%), pengurangan risiko jatuh pada pasien masih kurang (81,8%). Penerapan sasaran keselamatan pasien oleh Perawat sebagian besar masih kurang (54,5%).

Simpulan: penelitian ini menunjukkan bahwa penerapan sasaran keselamatan pasien oleh Perawat di RSUD Kesesi sebagian besar masih kurang. Diharapkan rumah sakit dapat mengadakan pelatihan untuk meningkatkan kepatuhan Perawat dalam penerapan sasaran keselamatan pasien.

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OVERVIEW OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF PATIENT SAFETY GOALS IN NURSES AT THE REGIONAL GENERAL HOSPITAL KESESI PEKALONGAN DISTRICT

ABSTRACT

Background: patient safety is a top priority related to service quality and hospital image. Nurses play an important and crucial role in ensuring care care focuses on patient safety and patient injury prevention during treatment. This study aims to determine the picture of the application of patient safety targets to nurses at the Kesesi Regional General Hospital.

Methods: descriptive research with cross sectional design. The sampling technique uses purposive sampling with a total sample of 44 implementing nurses. The instrument uses the International Patient Safety Goals questionnaire. The results of the study were analyzed by univariate analysis

Results: characteristics of respondents mostly aged 36-45 years (61.4%), female (61.4%), education level DIII Nursing (88.6%) with a working period of ≥ 5 years (72.7%). The application of accuracy of patient identification is good (100%), effective communication is still lacking (77.3%), improvement in drug safety that needs to be watched out for is still lacking (61.4%), certainty of right-location, right-procedure, right-patient surgery is good (100%), reduction in the risk of infection related to health services is still lacking (56.8%), reduction in the risk of falling in patients is still lacking (81.8%). Nurses' implementation of patient safety goals is largely lacking (54.5%).

Conclusion: this study shows that the implementation of patient safety targets by nurses at Kesesi Regional General Hospital is still largely lacking. It is expected that the hospital can conduct training to improve nurse compliance in the implementation of patient safety goals.
