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GAMBARAN TINGKAT PENGETAHUAN IBU HAMIL TENTANG ANTE-NATAL CARE (ANC) TERPADU DI WILAYAH KERJA PUSKESMAS SUMOWONO

ABSTRAK

Latar Belakang : Pengetahuan ibu hamil tentang *antenatal care* (ANC) terpadu sangat penting karena dapat membantu mengurangi angka kematian pada ibu dan bayi yang dilahirkan. Setiap kehamilan mempunyai risiko atau komplikasi oleh karena itu pelayanan *antenatal care* (ANC) terpadu harus dilakukan secara rutin dan sesuai standar. Pengetahuan menjadi faktor penting, jika seorang ibu hamil memiliki pengetahuan yang baik terkait *antenatal care* (ANC) terpadu maka dapat mendorong dirinya untuk memeriksakan kehamilannya.

Tujuan Penelitian : Untuk mengetahui gambaran tingkat pengetahuan ibu hamil tentang pengertian, tujuan, bentuk, standar dan kunjungan *antenatal care* (ANC) terpadu di Wilayah Kerja Puskesmas Sumowono.

Metode : Jenis penelitian ini adalah penelitian kuantitatif, menggunakan metode deskriptif kuantitatif. Populasi dalam penelitian ini adalah 224 responden, dengan jumlah sampel 69 responden. Teknik pengambilan sampel menggunakan *Kuota Sampling*. Instrument penelitian menggunakan kuesioner, dan analisa data menggunakan analisis univariat.

Hasil : Hasil penelitian menunjukan bahwa pengetahuan ibu hamil tentang pengertian pelayanan *antenatal care* (ANC) terpadu sebagian besar kurang sebanyak 56 responden (81,2%), pengetahuan ibu hamil tentang tujuan pelayanan *antenatal care* (ANC) terpadu sebagian besar kurang sebanyak 51 responden (74,0%), pengetahuan ibu hamil tentang bentuk pelayanan *antenatal care* (ANC) terpadu sebagian besar baik sebanyak 60 responden (87,0%), pengetahuan ibu hamil tentang standar pelayanan *antenatal care* (ANC) terpadu sebagian besar kurang sebanyak 26 responden (37,7%), pengetahuan ibu hamil tentang kunjungan pelayanan *antenatal care* (ANC) terpadu sebagian besar kurang sebanyak 58 responden (84,1%).

Kesimpulan : Pengetahuan Ibu Hamil tentang *Antenatal Care* (ANC) Terpadu di Wilayah Kerja Puskesmas Sumowono dari 69 responden dalam kategori pengetahuan baik sebanyak 16 responden (23,2%), pengetahuan cukup sebanyak 24 responden (34,8) dan tingkat pengetahuan kurang sebanyak 29 responden (42,0%).

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OVERVIEW OF PREGNANT WOMEN'S KNOWLEDGE LEVEL ABOUT ANTE-NATAL CARE (ANC) INTEGRATED IN THE WORKING AREA OF THE SUMOWONO PUSKESMAS

ABSTRACT

Background : Pregnant women's knowledge about *antenatal care* Integrated (ANC) is very important because it can help reduce the death rate for mothers and babies born. Every pregnancy has risks or complications therefore the service *antenatal care* Integrated (ANC) must be carried out routinely and according to standards. Knowledge is an important factor, if a pregnant woman has good knowledge regarding *antenatal care* Integrated (ANC) can encourage her to have her pregnancy checked.

Research purposes : To determine the level of knowledge of pregnant women regarding the meaning, goals, forms, standards and visits *antenatal care* (ANC) integrated in the Sumowono Community Health Center Working Area.

Method : This type of research is quantitative research, using quantitative descriptive methods. The population in this study was 224 respondents, with a sample size of 69 respondents. The sampling technique uses *Sampling Quota*. The research instrument used a questionnaire, and data analysis used univariate analysis.

Results : The research results show that pregnant women's knowledge about the meaning of service *antenatal care* Integrated (ANC) is mostly lacking as many as 56 respondents (81.2%), pregnant women's knowledge about the purpose of the service *antenatal care* Integrated (ANC) is mostly lacking as many as 51 respondents (74.0%), pregnant women's knowledge about the form of service *antenatal care* Integrated (ANC) was mostly good with 60 respondents (87.0%), pregnant women's knowledge of service standards *antenatal care* Integrated (ANC) is mostly lacking as many as 26 respondents (37.7%), pregnant women's knowledge about service visits *antenatal care* Integrated (ANC) is mostly lacking as many as 58 respondents (84.1%).

Conclusion : Pregnant Women's Knowledge about *Antenatal Care* (ANC) Integrated in the Sumowono Health Center Work Area, out of 69 respondents in the good knowledge category, 16 respondents (23.2%), 24 respondents had sufficient knowledge (34.8) and 29 respondents (42.0%) had a poor level of knowledge.
