## **CHAPTER V**

## CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTON

## **5.1 Conclusion**

Figurative language turns out to be very important and very interesting when used in a song. Figurative language is used in songs to keep listeners interested in the music and attract music fans attention. Based on the results and discussions above, it can be concluded that various types of figurative languages are found in NIKI's album "Nicole". There are some conclusions can be presented.

First, after analyzing the data, it can be conclude that several types figurative language used in twelve songs on the album Nicole by NIKI based in Kennedy and Gioia's (2005) theory. Out of the 10 types figurative language proposed by Kennedy and Gioia (2005), the researcher found 8 types figurative language in the album Nicole, such as simile, metaphor, personification, irony, paradox, synecdoche, repetition and hyperbole. The researcher did not find the use of apostrophe and allegory. Based on the table, the researcher found 38 expressions and the total data of figurative language in each types are: 3 that contain simile, 10 that contain metaphor, 5 that contain personification, 3 that contain irony, 4 that contain paradox, 1 that contain synecdoche, 6 that contain repetition, and 6 that contain hyperbole.

Second, the researcher also found that metaphor was the most dominant figurative language in the album "Nicole". The researcher found about 10 expressions that conduct figurative language metaphor which means the songwriter mostly used metaphor to express each lyric in her songs.in the

"Nicole" album used metaphors more often to describe her feelings in words that are easier to understand so that meaning of the song conveyed properly.

From the analysis, it can be conclude that figurative language proves to be both important and intriguing when used in 12 songs on NIKI album which has been analyzed by researcher because figurative language is able to beautify the song and this is very helpful for listeners to describe and fantasize stories and characters based on illustrations that have been given by the author of the lyrics of the song.

## **5.2 Suggestion**

This study explains the forms and meanings of figurative language used in 12 songs from the album Nicole by NIKI. The researcher hopes this study can enhance readers understanding and knowledge about types of figurative language and their meanings. Also, for the further researcher, particularly those who have some problems in conducting research, it suggested that this study can be a reference. Furthermore, the next researchers can use other theories in conducting their study. The researcher also suggests the further researcher can conduct similar studies with other songs or new album.
